How much do you need to raise?

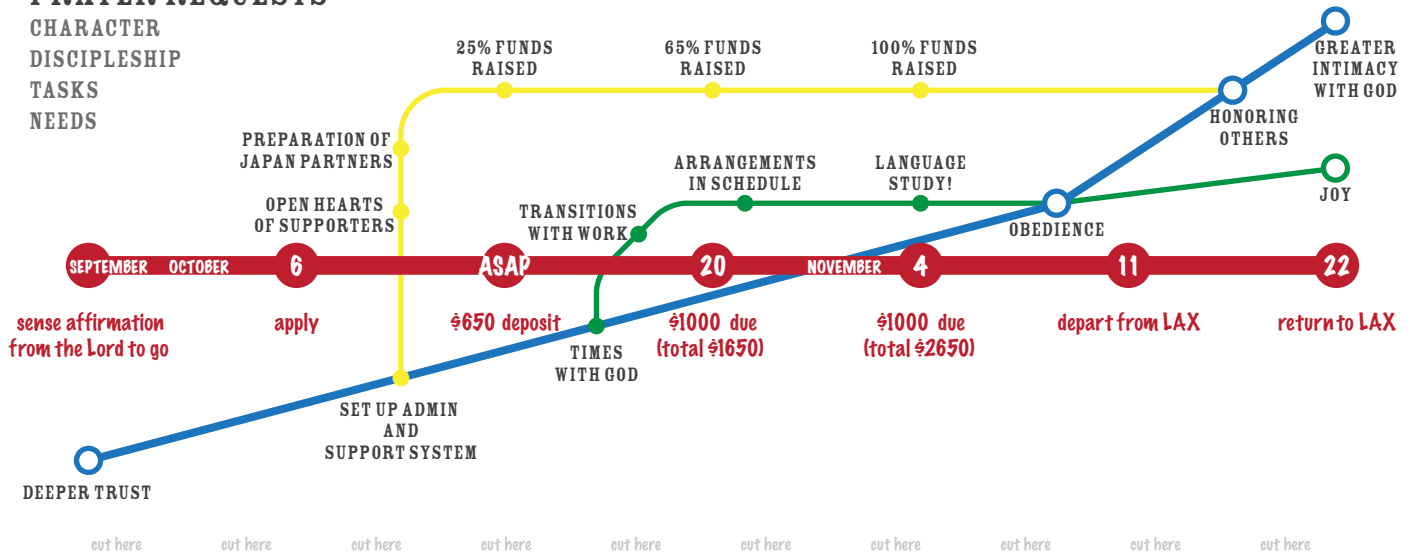
